GUY HOLT'S Bibliography of James Branch Cabell, published in 1924, has long been out of print. A persistent demand for a revised version of this standard work has resulted in the preparation of the present study, compiled, as was Mr. Holt's, with the sanction and assistance of James Branch Cabell. This represents the first and only complete Bibliography of the now finished Biography of the Life of Manuel as written by Mr. Cabell in the years 1901-1929.

A simple yet adequate method of collation, which we believe will be of great assistance to the collector and student, has been adopted. A number of additions and corrections have been made including the discovery of an important issue of Jurgen. Priority of English and American editions of the Pape illustrated Cabells has been determined and a variation of issue of Pape's Figures of Earth has been noted. The Bibliography has, of course, been brought up to date.

Several pirated editions and forgeries are discussed and a letter of Mr. Cabell's regarding the famous "Poor Jack" is reproduced in facsimile. The lists of contributions to books and periodicals and criticisms of James Branch Cabell contained in books and periodicals have been greatly augmented. Several of the more interesting and unusual title-pages and variants in binding are accurately reproduced in facsimile.

A new and unpublished photograph of Cabell adorns the book as a frontispiece and Mr. Cabell has contributed a new preface, "On Second Thought", to the Bibliography.

There will be 350 copies for sale at \$3.50 and a large paper edition, autographed by James Branch Cabell and the compiler, limited to 100 copies, 90 of which are for sale at \$10.00.
